WHAT TO BRING TO YOUR APPOINTMENT

- A form of photo ID.
- Completed (but unsigned) 'Application for Medical Certificate' form.
- Your receipt of payment from CAA.

APPOINTMENT INFORMATION

- You will be booked to see the nurse for the appropriate amount of time to do all appropriate testing.
- Testing may include;
 - Vision testing
 - ECG
 - Blood tests
 - Spirometry
 - Audiometry
- You will then see the doctor for 45 minutes for further assessment.
- You may have to be booked for fasting blood tests (water only from midnight) if required.

EYE TESTS

- If you wear glasses please bring these to the appointment.
- If you wear contacts these should be removed the evening prior to your appointment. Please bring them to the exam.
- Also bring your spare glasses with you.
- Special eye examinations, for initial applications, need to be done by an accredited CAA optician. You can arrange this appointment yourself.

COSTS

- General medical exam - \$250
- ECG - \$50
- Audiometry - \$50
- Spirometry - \$50
- Any laboratory fees associated with blood testing.
