

## SKYCERT

- Visit <https://www.skycert.nz/>
- Scroll down and click on the first blue circle (named pilots, skydivers and air traffic controllers).
- Follow instructions to get CAA number (if you do not already have one).
- Pay the CAA fee.
- Sign up to Skycert, fill out application form and tick box at bottom to sign.

## WHAT TO BRING TO YOUR APPOINTMENT

- A form of photo ID.

## APPOINTMENT INFORMATION

- You will be booked to see the nurse for the appropriate amount of time to do all appropriate testing.
- Testing may include;
  - Vision testing
  - ECG
  - Blood tests
  - Spirometry
  - Audiometry
- You will then see the doctor for 45 minutes for further assessment.

## EYE TESTS

- If you wear glasses please bring these to the appointment.
- If you wear contacts these should be removed the evening prior to your appointment. Please bring them to the exam.
- Also bring your spare glasses with you.
- Special eye examinations, for initial applications, need to be done by an accredited CAA optician. The closest to Wanaka is Katie Hill, Optometrist at Central Otago Optical in Cromwell on 03 445 4561. It may take a few weeks to get an appt so do this asap and make sure you tell them it's for an aviation medical.

## COSTS

- General medical exam - \$285
- ECG - \$55
- Audiometry - \$55
- Spirometry - \$60
- Blood Draw fee - \$16
- Any laboratory fees associated with blood testing
